

Michigan Behavioral Health Internship Stipend Program

The Michigan Behavioral Health Internship Stipend Program (MI-BHISP) aims to increase the number of qualified behavioral health professionals in Michigan by providing a stipend of **up to \$15,000** to eligible students.

You may be eligible for a stipend of up to \$15,000, if both of the following are true:

- ✓ You are pursuing a bachelor's or master's degree to become a:
 - Marriage or Family Therapist.
 - Behavior Analyst.
 - Social Worker.
 - Professional Counselor.
 - Psychologist.
- ✓ You have secured an unpaid internship in a public behavioral health-based system in Michigan.
