2. **Approval of Agenda and Minutes from September 8, 2025 – Motion to approve (Warnemuende, Sundberg). Approved.**
3. **Current Legislation Review**
 - A. HB 4857 – Remove Emergency Service Provider from CISM Tab 2
Removes language, intent to expand beyond emergency providers is the assumption
 - **Motion to support (Sundberg, Flynn). Approved.**
 - B. HB ~~4399~~ 4954 is the correct number– Responder Line of Duty Tuition Fund Tab 3
Adds in medical examiners as those that would qualify. Does not include EMS.
Something to voice concern about.
 - **Motion to oppose without EMS added (Nye, Flynn). Approved.**
 - C. HB 5051 and HB 5053 – Epi Delivery System Tab 4
53 think we have seen before, expand types of EPI that could be available for use, 51 talks about purchasing EPI, includes law enforcement and fire, if they are EMS/Fire, it is inconsistent with pharmacy law. Emily advises this one there isn't concern about the actual medicine (it's the same), it more correctly covers (53), when it's allowed in the law, they will look to MCAs. Another concern is expense. This is expanding the variety of different delivery of EPI.
 - **Motion to present 5053 to EMSCC with No action/recommendation (Warnemuende, Hood). Approved.**
 - **Motion to oppose as written (Nye, Flynn) to present 5051 to EMSCC with recommendation to change language to exclude non-EMS agencies. Approved**

- D. SB 591 – Health Club AED Usage – No Duty to Act Tab 5
 - **Recommendation before was no action. Motion to take no action (Miljan, Sundberg). Approved.**
- E. HIB 4432 – Income Tax Credit (added)
For volunteer EMS and personnel.
 - **Motion to support (Flynn, Sundberg). Approved.**
