

Workgroup Journey







Option


Options are the approaches to address Conflict-Free Access and Planning that will be considered by the State. Options still need to be developed. The State has not chosen an option.

 - Identify missing areas and draft Sub-Criteria
- Document changes in breakout group's worksheet.
- Try to not define the "Who" or "How". Ensure Sub-Criteria are relevant regardless of provider, population, geographic area, and region.


