

**EXHIBIT 1****PERSONAL PROPERTY NOT ALLOWED IN PATIENT ROOMS**

Patients must be made aware of these prohibited items at the time of admission and that possession of these items on their person or in their room is not allowed. These items do not need to be limited through the IPOS. **If a patient has any of these items with them upon admission, they will be appropriately inventoried and stored for access at designated times/locations. Items that are provided by the hospital for patient use (hygiene supplies, office/craft supplies) may be used at specific times, in specific places, and must be returned to staff after use.**

Prohibited Items	Examples include, but are not limited to, the following:	
Hygiene and grooming items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Nail files</li><li>• Nail clippers</li><li>• Hair dryers</li><li>• Curling irons/straighteners</li><li>• Items in aerosol cans</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Razors (all types)</li><li>• Combs and picks (all types)</li><li>• Scissors</li><li>• Nail polish and remover</li><li>• Dental floss</li></ul>

Musical Instruments	• Access to musical instruments brought by patient will be determined by treatment team	
Other personal belongings*	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Jewelry (all types)</li><li>• All cash (paper and coin)</li><li>• Credit/debit/ATM/Bridge cards</li><li>• Checkbooks</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Driver's license/state ID</li><li>• Social security card</li><li>• USB devices</li></ul>
The possession or use of any item which would violate a federal, state or local law.		

**\*Patients wishing to have these items in their possession must sign a waiver that releases the hospital from responsibility should they be lost, damaged, or stolen.**

**EXHIBIT 2****ITEMS PROHIBITED FROM POSSESSION AT ANY TIME**

Patients must be made aware of these prohibitions at the time of admission and that possession of these items while in the hospital is not allowed. These items do not need to be limited through the IPOS. **If a patient has any of these items with them upon admission, they will be appropriately inventoried, stored and/or relinquished. Hospitals and Centers will not store firearms, knives, explosive devices, alcoholic beverages, or illegal drugs, including marijuana, in any form.**

Prohibited Items	Examples include, but are not limited to, the following:

Street drugs/substances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Any drug/substance considered illegal to possess by the Federal Government</li> </ul>	
Alcohol and beverages	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Alcoholic beverages of any type</li> <li>• Products containing alcohol that can be used for intoxication</li> <li>• Energy drinks (all types)</li> </ul>	
Tobacco related products	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cigarettes</li> <li>• Cigars</li> <li>• Vape pens/electronic smoking devises</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pipes</li> <li>• Chewing tobacco</li> <li>• Snuff</li> <li>• All other tobacco products and simulated items</li> </ul>
