## Directions for Tobacco, Vapor, and Alternative Nicotine Product Retailer Updates

For FY2022, the Master Retailer List (MRL) must be updated to include all retailers selling tobacco and/or ENDS products. Updating the retailer list will

- help determine which establishments will be visited for retail education and/or other non-Synar activity,
- improve the quality of the list to keep from having unnecessary ineligible sites during the formal Synar survey, and
- ensure accuracy of tobacco retail establishments for the required coverage study (conducted every three years).

OROSC will use the updated MRL for determining Synar compliance check selections and for sending correspondence to tobacco/ENDS retailers.

Each MRL excel document will include two tabs. The first tab will include tobacco and/or ENDS retailers eligible for Synar inspections. The second tab will include tobacco and/or ENDS retailers not eligible for a Synar inspection (e.g., retailer not accessible by youth under age 21). See table below for additional guidance for the two tabs. **BOTH TABS MUST BE UPDATED FOR ACCURATE RECORDING.**

### **NOTE on Retailer Exclusion:**

- **Retailers on tribal property or owned by a tribal entity should not be included in the MRL. The State does not have jurisdiction of these retailers.**
- **Marijuana establishments should not be included in the MRL as the Marihuana Act reads “No marihuana establishment may sell or otherwise transfer tobacco.”**

See below for instructions on completing relevant columns in each of the tabs.

➤ MRL # (Column A)

- Tab 1 will be prefilled with the MRL # for all current retailers. This number is established by OROSC so this column will be left blank for added establishments.
- Tab 2 this column will be left blank.

➤ A/R/S/D (Column B)

For both tabs, type in the first letter only of revision key to indicate status.

<b>Revision Key</b>	<b>Explanation</b>
<b>A = ADD</b>	Add a new establishment.
<b>R = REVISE</b>	Revisions or corrections OTHER than closure. Revisions include changes such as revised name, address, telephone, vendor type, etc.
<b>S = SAME</b>	Listing remains the same, no change.
<b>D = DELETE</b>	Delete or remove listing - No longer exists or closed business. Does not sell tobacco or ENDS products.

Provide an explanation for any Deletions (D) or Revisions (R) in the "NOTES" column showing former information (see "Example" on page 4). For Revisions, delete the old detail and using **bold type** and CAPITAL letters, key in any new information in columns C through O.

When adding a new establishment insert a new row then type an "A" in column B and using **bold type** and CAPITAL letters, enter information for columns C through O. "New" does not need to be written in the Notes column. Leave column A "MRL#" blank as OROSC will complete this column once a new establishment has been verified.

For any establishment with no change, verify that they have been checked by typing in the letter "S" in column B. "Same" does not need to be written in the Notes column.

If a retailer on Tab 1 sells either tobacco or ENDS but is no longer eligible for Synar. Delete that retailer from Tab 1 and place them on Tab 2.

➤ Sells Tobacco / Sells ENDS (Column C and D)

In column C and D enter "Y" if establishment sells tobacco or Electronic Nicotine Delivery Systems (ENDS), respectively or "N" if the retailer is not known to sell these products. Both of these columns must have a Y or N entered for each retailer.

➤ Retailer Information (Columns C – O)

Ensure accuracy of these columns for each retailer. Make any changes to these columns in **bold** font and use CAPITAL letters. Ensure that information is filled in for each retailer (no blank spaces)

➤ Notes (Column P)

Use the NOTES column to provide any additional information regarding the retailer (e.g., seasonal, alternate mailing address)

➤ OROSC Comments (Column Q)

OROSC staff will use this column to communicate any pertinent information or ask questions about the retailer.

## Directions for Tobacco, Vapor, and Alternative Nicotine Product Retailer Updates

Note the following information:

- ✓ PIHPs should use the most current version of its MRL sent by OROSC staff for the current fiscal year.
- ✓ If PIHPs separate the list to disseminate to DYTURs then PIHPs must ensure that all retailers are combined for the final MRL submission to OROSC.
- ✓ If a retailer no longer sells both tobacco and ENDS then that retailer should be marked for deletion from the list.
- ✓ Verify the work (e.g., check duplicates) to minimize return questions or the necessity to "do over" any particular retailer listing.
- ✓ Ensure that columns B through O are completed for each retailer.
- ✓ The final updated MRL sent to OROSC should be in black font color, all content should be in CAPITAL letters, and any changes (including information for new retailers) in **bold**.

**Synar Master Retailer List (MRL) Glossary of Terms**

<b>Master Retailer List</b>	A statewide composite of retailers known to sell tobacco and/or vaping products. It is sorted by Prepaid Inpatient Health Plan (PIHP) region
<b>MRL #</b>	The OROSC assigned retailer number - used for tracking
<b>ENDS</b>	Electronic Nicotine Delivery Systems
<b>CO</b>	The county in which the retailer or business is located
<b>CO Code</b>	The state assigned number identifying the respective counties
<b>OTC/VM</b>	Used to describe whether the type of sell is <b>OTC</b> = Over the Counter; or <b>VM</b> = Vending Machine.
<b>Vendor Type</b>	A code number that indicates the type of business or retail establishment. There are seven codes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 01 = Gas Station</li> <li>• 02 = Tobacco Store</li> <li>• 03 = Restaurant</li> <li>• 04 = Hotel</li> <li>• 05 = Grocery Store</li> <li>• 06 = Drug Store</li> <li>• 07 = Other (please indicate)</li> </ul>
<b>Retailer Name</b>	Name of business or retail establishment as shown on building.
<b>Street Address</b>	Physical address of establishment being checked.
<b>City</b>	City coinciding with establishment address.
<b>State</b>	Will always be Michigan.
<b>Zip</b>	Zip code coinciding with establishment address.
<b>Phone</b>	Telephone number of the establishment.

## **Glossary of Synar Codes and Establishment Types (Type of Retailer)**

- (01) **Gas Station:** A retail station for servicing motor vehicles especially with gasoline and oil. Sometimes have an affiliate convenience store or fast-food vendor on site. Examples are Shell, Mobil and Valero.
- (02) **Tobacco Store:** A specialty tobacco store where the main products sold are tobaccos and/or ENDS.
- (03) **Restaurant:** A business that prepares and serves food and drink to customers in return for money. Some examples: Applebee's, Friday's, and local restaurants. [Note: As a result of the clean air act, most restaurants no longer sell tobacco products, however, some have adjacent bars/lounges.]
- (04) **Hotel:** An establishment that provides lodging and sometimes meals, entertainment, and various personal services for the public.
- (05) **Grocery Store:** A retail store that primarily sells groceries and household goods with a limited number of nonfood items. Some of the larger chain grocery stores may have an adjacent gas station with the same name. Some examples: Kroger Supermarket, IGA, Whole Foods, Ma & Pa Markets (small retail outlet usually owned and operated by an individual or family).
- (06) **Drug Store:** A pharmacy which also sells a myriad of other items. Some examples: Rite Aid, Walgreens, CVS.
- (07) **Other:** Includes businesses such as Convenience Store (independent, not affiliated with gas station), Bar/Lounge, and "Big Box" retailers who offer a wide array of products and services (e.g., Walmart, Target, Meijer, Dollar General, Family Dollar).
