Do you have insured patients with high deductibles who need breast or cervical diagnostics, but can't afford it?

The Breast and Cervical Cancer Control Navigation Program (BC3NP) pays for diagnostics, in addition to screening services.

Women who have mammograms and Pap tests paid by insurance, but need diagnostics for follow-up of a breast or cervical abnormality, may be eligible for BC3NP services if they have a high deductible.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the BC3NP, a woman must be:

- Between ages 21-64 with a breast or cervical abnormality.
- Have a yearly income at or below 250% of federal poverty guidelines.
