 SUBJECT: 2026 Federal Poverty Guidelines

The new poverty guidelines from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services have been published in the Federal Register for 2026. The 2026 poverty guidelines and calculation of 250% of poverty levels used for the direct service programs (BC3NP and WISEWOMAN) can be found in the table below.

Effective immediately, these guidelines are to be used to determine program eligibility.
