Quick Facts

- 1 The inflatable lungs exhibit requires approximately 10 feet by 12 feet of floor space and takes approximately 30 minutes to set up and break down.
- 2 For indoor events, a 10-foot ceiling height is necessary.
- 3 The inflatable lungs can plug into a standard three-pronged outlet.
