



## Brief overview of the Breast and Cervical Cancer Control Navigation Program (BC3NP):

The Breast and Cervical Cancer Control Navigation Program (BC3NP) provides low-income women access to breast and cervical cancer screening services (mammograms and Pap tests) and follow-up care if needed. The program does not pay for cancer treatment, but women may be eligible for a special Medicaid program through BC3NP that will.

## Brief overview of WISEWOMAN Program:

WISEWOMAN (Well-Integrated Screening and Evaluation for WOMen Across the Nation) helps participants understand and identify their risk for heart disease, stroke, and diabetes. WISEWOMAN offers free clinical assessments, risk reduction counseling, and health coaching to help participants make healthy lifestyle changes.

### Eligibility Requirements:

The following information **MUST** be determined **PRIOR** to enrolling women:

- **Current Michigan Resident**
- **Total Household Income:** At or below 250% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. **Please scan the QR code** for the most current information.



*Note: Clients are not required to submit proof of income.*

### **Age Requirement for BC3NP:**

- 21 – 64 years old and requiring cervical screening/diagnostic services
- 40 – 64 years old and requiring breast screening/diagnostic/treatment services
  - » or 18-39 years and referred to BC3NP with an abnormal clinical breast exam (CBE) or abnormal breast imaging which requires diagnostic services

### **Age Requirement for WISEWOMAN:**

- 35 – 64 years old

### **Insurance Status**

- People with no insurance
- People with high-deductible insurance that must be met before receiving diagnostic procedures.
  - » Note: Screening tests should be covered by your insurance and do not affect your deductible. A high deductible is a cost you cannot afford to pay PRIOR to receiving diagnostic tests or procedures.

Women who are enrolled in a managed care program, a health maintenance organization, or Medicare Part B are not eligible for the BC3NP.



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
