The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) has openings for program-eligible women to receive free cancer and health screenings.

BC3NP

The BC3NP provides free breast and cervical cancer screening services to low-income women in Michigan. The BC3NP does not pay for cancer treatment. However, women diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer may be eligible for a special Medicaid program that does.

WISEWOMAN

The WISEWOMAN Program, available in select areas of the state, helps participants understand their chronic disease risk factors and make healthy lifestyle choices. Every participant receives a free health screening and an opportunity to discuss their health with a health coach. In addition, eligible women can choose to participate in free healthy behavior support services.

## ELIGIBILITY

**Women are eligible for services based on the following criteria:**

- Between the ages of 21 and 64 for the BC3NP.
- Between the ages of 35 and 64 for WISEWOMAN.
- Uninsured or underinsured with a high deductible the woman may be unable to pay prior to receiving services.
- Household income at or below 250% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.
