INFLUENZA 	Vaccine targets three strains of seasonal flu.	6 months and older.	Reduces health care visits due to symptoms by 40-60%.	October is ideal, but you can get vaccine as long as flu viruses continue to circulate.
COVID-19 	Multiple options available.	6 months and older.	Last fall, the vaccine provided 40-60% effectiveness against severe disease.	October is ideal, but you can get vaccine as long as viruses continue to circulate.
RSV 	Multiple options available.	75 years and older, those ages 60-74 at increased risk of RSV disease, and pregnant persons.*	75-82% efficacy against severe disease.	Talk to your health care provider today.
RSV PROTECTIVE ANTIBODY 	Note: This is not a vaccine, but a proactive immunizing agent that provides antibodies.	All infants younger than 8 months and high-risk infants 8-19 months.	Reduces risk of hospitalizations and health care visits by approximately 80%.	Talk to your health care provider today.

*RSV vaccine Abrysvo is recommended for pregnant persons 32-36 weeks gestation during RSV season (September through January).
