

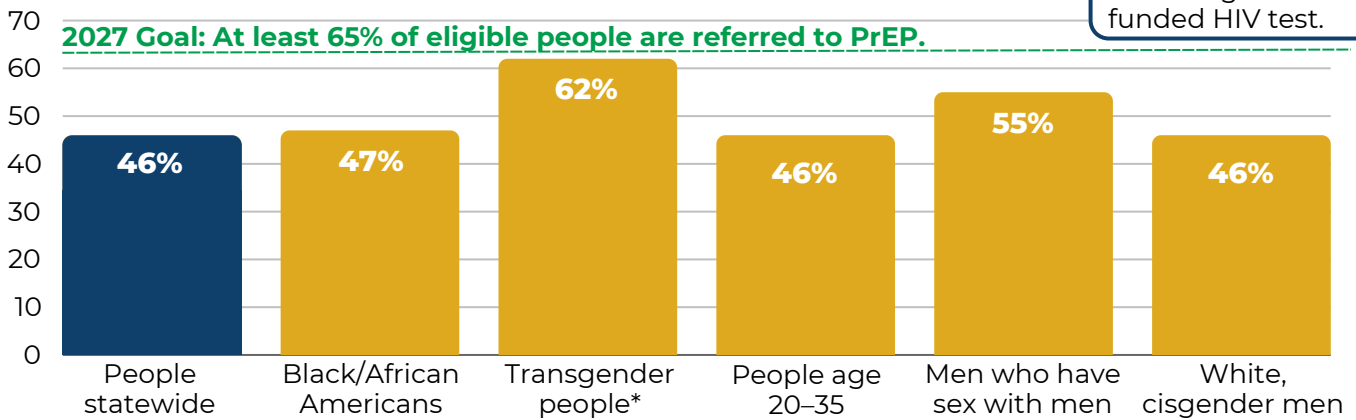

Goal Three

Priority Topic: PrEP Linkage

A central goal of **Michigan's Equitable Plan** is to increase referrals to pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) among eligible people who test negative for HIV statewide. **The goal is to increase the referral rate to 65% by 2027.**

Percentage of Eligible People Referred to PrEP After a State-Funded HIV Test by Priority Population, 2022



What am I looking at?
The **higher** the percentage, the more people were referred to PrEP among those eligible after a state-funded HIV test.

Activities in Michigan's Equitable Plan to Improve PrEP Linkage

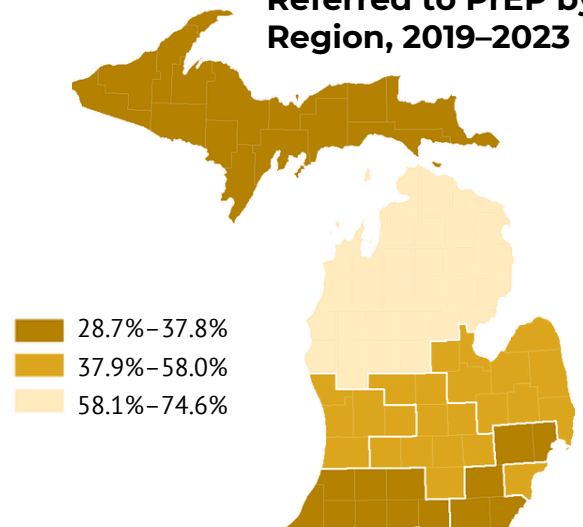
Connect patients with the providers actively prescribing PrEP in Michigan, especially in the geographies with the highest need.

Partner with providers, health systems, community organizations, pharmacists and others to develop and improve PrEP access and uptake practices.

Expand awareness of PrEP through trainings, conferences and community education campaigns.

Use and improve the quality and accessibility of PrEP data to make progress toward program goals.

What am I looking at?
Areas shaded in darker yellow have a lower proportion of people who received PrEP referrals and represent possible opportunities for increased focus.

*Due to data limitations, MDHHS is often unable to confirm that someone identifies as transgender unless they are retained in care. This means individuals who identify as transgender but are not referred for PrEP may be undercounted, potentially inflating this rate.
