RESOURCE GUIDE INTRODUCTION

MDHHS Bureau of HIV and STI Programs

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, Bureau of HIV and STI Programs, HIV Care Section (MDHHS) Ryan White (RW) Program provides a comprehensive system of HIV primary medical care, essential support services and medications for low-income HIV-positive consumers who are uninsured and underserved. MDHHS partners with health departments, hospitals, universities, and community-based organizations to provide core medical and support services to people living with HIV throughout all life stages, including specialty care during pregnancy.

This resource guide contains a list of HIV medical providers, including their available services offered throughout the state with additional support service information for pregnant women, new mothers, and infants.

HIV SUPPORT SERVICE CATEGORIES

**Support services vary by county*

Child Care Services – Supports intermittent childcare for the children of HIV-positive consumers, only while the consumer attends medical or other appointments or Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program Related meetings, groups, or training sessions.

Early Intervention Services – Identifies individuals at points of entry and provides access to services with the provision of these four components: HIV testing and targeted counseling, referral services, linkage to care, and health education and literacy training that enable consumers to navigate the HIV system of care.

Emergency Financial Assistance – Provides limited one-time or short-term payments to assist a consumer with an urgent need for essential items or services necessary to improve health outcomes, including utilities, housing, food, transportation, and medication.

Food Bank/Home-delivered – Provides food items, hot meals, nutritional supplements, or a voucher program to purchase food. This also includes the provision of essential non-food items that are limited to the following: personal hygiene products, household cleaning supplies, water filtration/purification systems in communities where issues of water safety exist.

Health Education/Risk Reduction – Provides education for consumers with HIV about HIV transmission and how to reduce the risk of HIV transmission.

Health Insurance Premium and Cost-sharing Assistance – Provides health insurance for comprehensive primary care and pharmacy coverage for low-income consumers, providing a full range of HIV medications; paying co-pays (including co-pays for prescription eyewear for conditions related to HIV infection) and deductibles on behalf of the consumer.

Home and Community-Based Health Services – Provides services to an eligible consumer in an integrated setting appropriate to that consumer's needs, based on a written plan of care established by a medical care team under the direction of a licensed clinical provider.

Home Health Care – Provides services in the home that are appropriate to an eligible consumer's needs and are performed by licensed professionals.

Hospice Services – Provides end-of-life care services provided to consumers in the terminal stage of an HIV-related illness.

Housing Services – Provides transitional, short-term, or emergency housing assistance to enable a consumer or family to gain or maintain outpatient/ambulatory health services and treatment, including temporary assistance necessary to prevent homelessness and to achieve or maintain access to medical care.

Linguistic Services – Provides interpretation and translation activities, both oral and written to eligible consumers.

Medical Case Management – Provides a range of consumer-centered activities focused on improving health outcomes in support of the HIV care continuum.

Medical Nutrition Therapy – Provides nutrition assessment and screening, dietary/nutritional evaluation, food and/or nutritional supplements per medical provider’s recommendation, and nutrition education and/or counseling.

Medical Transportation Services – Provides nonemergency transportation that enables an eligible consumer to access core medical and support services related to HIV care.

Mental Health Services – Provides outpatient psychological and psychiatric screening, assessment, diagnosis, and counseling offered to consumers with HIV.

Michigan HIV/AIDS Drug Assistance Program – Covers HIV-specific and related medicines as well as vaccines.

Non-Medical Case Management – Provides a range of consumer-centered activities focused on improving access to and retention in needed core medical and support services.

Oral Healthcare – Provides outpatient activities including outpatient diagnosis, prevention, and therapy provided by dental health care professionals, including general dental practitioners, dental specialists, dental hygienists, and licensed dental assistants.

Other Professional Services – Provision of professional and consultant services rendered by members of professions licensed and/or qualified to offer such services by local governing authorities.

Outpatient Ambulatory Health Services – Provides diagnostic and therapeutic-related activities directly to a consumer by a licensed healthcare provider in an outpatient medical setting.

Outreach Services – Provides identification of people with HIV who either do or do not know their HIV status or who know their status but are not currently in care. Additional services include linkage to care or reengagement of care.

Psychosocial Support Services – Provides group or individual support and counseling services to assist consumers to address behavioral and physical health concerns.

Referral for Health Care and Support Services – Provides services to consumer to needed

core medical or support services in person or through telephone, written, or other type of communication.

Rehabilitation Services – Provides HIV-related therapies intended to improve or maintain a consumer’s quality of life and optimal capacity for self-care on an outpatient basis, and in accordance with an individualized plan of HIV care.

Respite Care – Provides periodic respite care in the community or home-based settings that includes non-medical assistance designed to provide care for a consumer to relieve the primary caregiver responsible for their day-to-day care.

Substance Abuse Treatment Services-Outpatient – Provides outpatient services for the treatment of drug or alcohol use disorders.

The Michigan Drug Assistance Program Premium Assistance Program – Helps consumers obtain or maintain a Qualified Health Plan through the Health Insurance Marketplace, a Medicare Part C Plan (Advantage Plan), (Prescription Plan) or a COBRA Plan
