


# Reverse an Opioid Overdose with Naloxone

1

## CHECK

Check for breathing and try to wake the person up.



2

## CALL

Call 911.



3

## BREATHE

Support breathing with chest compressions (with or without rescue breathing).



4

## SPRAY

If no response, administer naloxone. **See reverse for detailed instructions for each type of naloxone applicator.**

5

## STAY

Continue chest compressions until the person is breathing on their own. Place the person on their side and stay until help arrives.





## NASAL SPRAY INSTRUCTIONS




1. Hold device with thumb on bottom of plunger and two fingers around the nozzle. Spray firmly into the nostril.\*


## INTRANASAL SPRAY INSTRUCTIONS




1. Pull or pry off both top and bottom covers on the syringe.



2. Screw the white cone onto the top of the barrel of syringe.




3. Pry off the cap of the naloxone capsule.



4. Screw naloxone cartridge into the barrel of syringe.

5. Insert white cone into nostril. Give a short push on the end of the naloxone cartridge. One half of the cartridge goes into each nostril.\*



\*Additional doses may be given every 2–3 minutes until the person responds. Continue chest compressions between doses.
