



Diamond Shroomz Recall Update

Public Health Bulletin for Health Care Providers – July 2024

Dear Colleagues,

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) is alerting Michigan residents that Prophet Premium Blends, the producer of Diamond Shroomz-brand products, in coordination with the Food & Drug Administration (FDA), has **issued a recall** of all Diamond Shroomz products due to the **risk of serious illness**.

MDHHS and the FDA are urging Michigan residents to not eat, sell or serve any flavor of Diamond Shroomz-brand chocolate bars, infused cones or micro- and mega/extreme-dose gummies, and instead **throw them away**.

In light of the recall, we are asking the following:

1. **If you have cared for a patient that has consumed Diamond Shroomz-brand products and experienced illness with moderate or major clinical effects, report the case to MDHHS** at 844-464-7327, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., or at MDHHS-eh@mdhhs.gov, which is monitored daily Monday through Friday. Cases can also be reported to the [Poison Help Line](#) at 800-222-1222.
2. **Consider discussing this information with parents and caregivers of individuals under the age of 18.** Due to these products being marketed as candy, they might appeal to those under the age of 18.

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Diamond Shroomz-brand product investigation of illnesses

People in multiple states have reported a variety of severe symptoms after eating Diamond Shroomz-brand products. Alongside the FDA, Prophet Premium Blends will continue to investigate the cause of these serious adverse health effects.

As of July 16, 2024, a total of 69 cases, including 36 hospitalizations, have been confirmed in 28 states. No deaths have been confirmed. There are no confirmed cases in Michigan. People who became ill from eating Diamond Shroomz-brand products reported a variety of severe symptoms including seizures and central nervous system depression, including loss of consciousness, confusion, sleepiness, agitation, abnormal heart rates, hyper/hypotension, nausea and vomiting.

Prophet Premium Blends has ceased production and distribution of the Diamond Shroomz-brand products.

Recommendations

- Inform your patients that those who experience adverse health effects after consuming these products should seek medical treatment and/or call the [Poison Help Line](#) at 800-222-1222.
- Consumers should check their homes and discard these products or return them to the company for a refund.
- Promote harm reduction messages if appropriate. MDHHS has become aware that some residents are seeking out Diamond Shroomz-brand products and will continue to use them despite the recall and official messaging to do otherwise. In these cases, providing harm reduction messaging helps protect communities. If appropriate, you may choose to include the following harm reduction messages when sharing information about the Diamond Shroomz-brand product recall with patients:
 - To reduce the risk of serious harm, such as seizures or hospitalization, consider the following if using recalled Diamond Shroomz-brand products or other mushroom-containing products:

- Do not use while alone.
- Start with a small dose and follow directions on the packaging.
- Do not mix substances.
