

Medicaid Doula Services Billing Guidance

The information below includes information for Medicaid Fee-for-Service (FFS) coverage of doula services. Submit claims for Medicaid Fee-for-Service beneficiaries in CHAMPS. For doula services rendered to individuals enrolled in a Medicaid Health Plan, consult with each Medicaid Health Plan for reimbursement and claims submission information.

Claims must include the required modifier(s) and the *primary* diagnosis identified in the table below.

Diagnosis Codes Representing Social Determinants of Health

Providers are encouraged to report a *secondary* diagnosis code, as applicable, for reporting social determinants of health (SDOH) that identify factors influencing health status and contact with health services. SDOH codes help the State to identify areas of need and focus efforts accordingly to better support beneficiaries. ***This table provides examples of SDOH codes and is not meant to be an all-inclusive list. Refer to the most current ICD-10-CM coding guidelines for the most up-to-date official code set.***
