The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) is holding a webinar to gather feedback about potential changes to the Medicaid MI Choice Waiver program. One of the potential changes to the program is adding a new service called Structured Family Caregiving (SFC). Addition of this service was included in Michigan legislation for Fiscal Year 2025. SFC is a service that allows family caregivers to be paid for delivering personal care services to the waiver participant and provides comprehensive supports to the caregiver.

MDHHS is partnering with ADvancing States to do this webinar. We invite you to join us to learn about SFC and the upcoming steps to add it to the MI Choice Waiver. Webinar topics will include:

- An overview of SFC and how it supports family caregivers
- Examples of SFC in other states
- Next steps for adding SFC to the MI Choice Waiver
