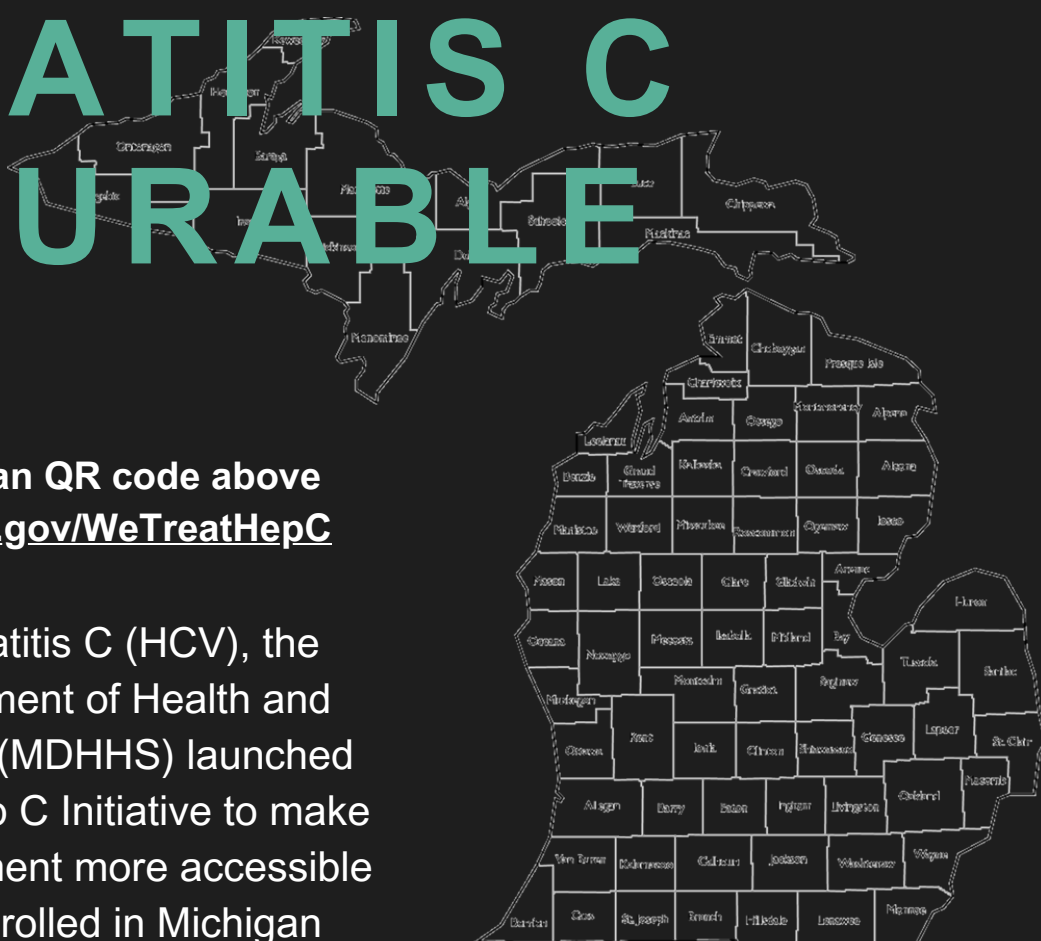




HEPATITIS C IS CURABLE

To eliminate hepatitis C (HCV), the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) launched the We Treat Hep C Initiative to make hepatitis C treatment more accessible among people enrolled in Michigan Medicaid and the Healthy Michigan Plan.

DID YOU KNOW?



TODAY'S STANDARD OF CARE INCLUDES TREATMENTS CALLED "DIRECT-ACTING ANTIVIRALS" OR DAAS.

HEPATITIS C HAS A HIGH CURE RATE OF 95% OR GREATER ACORDING TO CLINICAL STUDIES.



DAAs have little to no side effects.



Treatment is short in duration. HCV can be cured in as little as eight weeks.



Easily taken by mouth.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Michigan Medicaid and Healthy Michigan Plan enrollees can be treated for their hepatitis C infection **regardless of their recent or current substance use or liver damage**. In addition, enrollees may be treated by non-specialists, including primary care and advanced practice providers, for their hepatitis C infection.
