



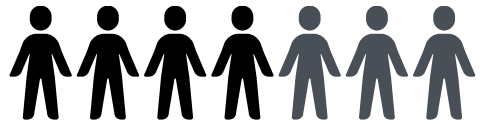
HEPATITIS C IS CURABLE

To eliminate hepatitis C (HCV), the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) launched the We Treat Hep C Initiative on April 1, 2021 to make hepatitis C treatment more accessible among people enrolled in Michigan Medicaid and the Healthy Michigan Plan.



DID YOU KNOW?

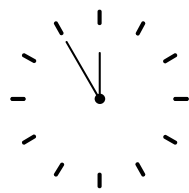


TODAY'S STANDARD OF CARE INCLUDES TREATMENTS CALLED "DIRECT-ACTING ANTIVIRALS" OR DAAS.

HEPATITIS C HAS A HIGH CURE RATE OF 95% OR GREATER ACORDING TO CLINICAL STUDIES.



DAAs have few to no side effects.



Treatment is short in duration. HCV can be cured in as little as 8 weeks.



Easily taken by mouth only.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Michigan Medicaid and Healthy Michigan Plan enrollees can be treated for their hepatitis C infection **regardless of their recent or current substance use or liver damage.** In addition, enrollees may be treated by non-specialists, including primary care and advanced practice providers, for their hepatitis C infection.
