Guest dosing at a local Lansing Clinic

Local Lansing clinic has offered to welcome and guest dose for attendees of the Michigan Harm Reduction Summit.

Please verify some of the following steps below in order to ensure a smoot transition between clinics for guest dosing:

1. Must meet with counselor at home clinic. Your counselor will put in the request.
2. The doctor at home clinic will need to sign off on request.
3. A release will need to be signed with your Home Clinic.
 - a. Have information of the Guest Clinic and be sure to approve the sharing of all the information they will need to verify with that specific clinic.
 - i. Name/address/phone and Fax # for the Guest Clinic. **THIS IS IMPORTANT!!!**
4. Confirm with the Home Clinic that everything was faxed to the Guest Clinic. (You can also request a copy of confirmation to bring to guest clinic).
5. Once you arrive at the Guest Clinic, check-in and let them know where you are from and that you are there to guest dose.

Continuing Education Credits

We have applied for continuing education credits for the following: Nursing (CNE), Michigan Social Work (MiSW), Community Health Worker (CHW), Addiction Professional (MCBAP), or Health Educators (CHES). Attendees requesting credits will be required to complete post-session evaluations. Information on accessing session evaluations will be provided at the end of each session.
