Going Fishing? Remember to Eat Safe Fish!

Fishing is fun! But, before you eat your catch, make sure your fish is safe to eat.



Do not eat the fish caught in the Lange or Revere Canals in St. Clair Shores.

These fish have unsafe levels of chemicals called PCBs. The chemicals can stay in your body for a long time, and may affect your health later.



Look for signs

Signs like this are posted around the Lange and Revere Canals that advise to **not** eat the fish caught from these waters.
