For health care professionals, ethical values are essential. For nurses, incorporating ethics into daily practice is foundational.

Nurses are bound by the nursing code of ethics to compassionately treat patients, do no harm, treat each patient fairly, and allow patients to make their own decisions regarding care as appropriate (ANA, 2015). During times of scarce medical resources and services, nurses may be presented with moral conflict during an emergency or disaster.
