Work Plan Objective Progress and Highlights:

Injury Prevention

Objective: By June 2021, the Region 7 Education and Injury Prevention Committee will create a resource document identifying evidence-based injury prevention programs available in the Region.

Progress: Initially completed. A survey is being sent to all partners to determine any changes in membership of the Education and Injury Prevention Committee following COVID. The State of Michigan injury prevention plan will be assigned to the committee for review and adoption as part of the regional plan. A second survey to determine status of IP programs being offered.

Communications

Objective: The Region 7 Infrastructure and Medical Oversight Committee will explore establishing an ad hoc “communications committee” composed of representatives from hospitals, life support agencies, the EMS system, the Region 7 Health Care Coalition, and the Region 7 Trauma Network.

Progress: Plans in place to build committee in concert with Region 7 Health Care Coalition as part of their proposed MCA/EMS subcommittee allowing RTN physicians and surgeons more time to focus on the RPSRO. Ongoing.

Infrastructure

Objective: The Infrastructure and Medical Oversight Committee will have established a written process for enhancing and ensuring collaboration of MCA directors and trauma medical directors in the development and periodic review of protocols for pre-hospital providers providing care to trauma patients.

Progress: Infrastructure and Medical Oversight Committee placed within the RPSRO as an ad hoc group tasked with this objective. Plan for protocol review fall 2022.

Regional Performance Improvement

Objective: By June 2021, the RPSRO will begin utilizing routine reports generated using regional trauma data and other databases to analyze and evaluate performance measures.

Progress: RPSRO template review was made a part of the quarterly RPSRO agenda.

Continuum of Care

Objective: The RTN will have extended invitations to rehabilitation services to participate as members of the Region 7 RTAC.

Progress: Partners are in the process of developing a list of SNFs and ECFs in the Region with hopes of reaching out with invitations to participate in R7 activities by conclusion of 2022.

Trauma Education
