Work Plan Objective Progress and Highlights:

Injury Prevention

Objective: A trauma system public information and education plan exists that heightens public awareness of trauma as a disease, the need for a trauma care system and the prevention of injury. The RTN will promote evidenced based primary injury prevention activities and projects.

Progress: Injury prevention for this quarter focused on Gun Safety and Water Safety. A presentation was given at the RTAC meeting, and information was prepared for all partners. The information shared is from nationally recognized organizations.

Communications

Indicator(s): An assessment of the needs of the general medical community, including physicians, nurses, pre-hospital care providers, and others, concerning trauma system information, has been conducted.

Progress: The Regional Trauma Coordinator continues to work with all network partners to ensure needed education and information is being shared. Information on burn surge, pediatrics, preparedness, injury prevention and educational offerings are shared with the group regularly.

Infrastructure

Indicator(s): The regional trauma network plan should ensure that the number, levels, and distribution of trauma facilities are communicated to all partners and stakeholders. The RTN should develop procedures to ensure that trauma patients are transported to an appropriate facility that is prepared to provide care.

Progress: The Region 1 Trauma Coordinator conducted an asset survey of all hospitals that will be shared with the MCA staff and hospital partners. The survey includes information on services provided by the hospitals to help facilitate transfer of patients to appropriate hospitals for both EMS and hospital partners.

Regional Performance Improvement

Indicator(s): Collected data from a variety of sources are used to review the appropriateness of all-inclusive regional trauma performance standards, from injury prevention through rehabilitation.

Progress: Region 1 continues to work on building the activities of the RPSRO. The inventories are shared with the group, and discussions are ongoing concerning what activities can be undertaken by this group with the current data available.

Continuum of Care

Objective: The lead agency has incorporated, within the trauma system plan and the trauma center standards, requirements for rehabilitation services including interfacility transfer of trauma patients to rehabilitation centers.

Progress: Region 1 TPM's were asked to identify rehab contacts within their facility.

Trauma Education

Objective: The regional trauma network establishes and ensures that appropriate levels of EMS, nursing and physician trauma training courses are provided on a regular basis.

Progress: The Regional Trauma Coordinator developed a PI Toolkit and a Pediatric Toolkit for the regional partners. These toolkits are designed to put needed information in one central place with links to broader information included.

Other relevant activities information:

The RTC is active in verification and designation activities, attending all visits and helping with facility and reviewer preparation. The Region 1 RTC has given presentations to several regions on preparing for the virtual visit.
