# Taking Pride in Prevention Program Annual Evaluation Report



Fiscal Year 2021

The Taking Pride in Prevention (TPIP) program is federally funded through the State Personal Responsibility Education Program (PREP). TPIP educates adolescents, 12-19 years, on both abstinence <u>and</u> contraception through the implementation of evidence-based and evidence-informed programs, along with addressing these three adulthood preparation subjects:



Healthy Relationships



Parent-Child Communication



Adolescent Development

The program uses evaluation to learn if it is reaching its goals and objectives. For the evaluation, TPIP funded agencies tracked participation in the program and hours of programming each youth received. Agencies also asked youth to take a state and federal survey before the program started and after it ended. Only youth who received at least one session of programming (n=2399), are represented in these programming and outcome results.












#### **TPIP SURVEY DEMOGRAPHICS**












#### **TPIP YOUTH'S DECISIONS**

Has being in the program made you more likely, about the same, or less likely to...? (Percentages represent how 'likely', 'less likely', or about the same youth would do the following)




#### TPIP YOUTH'S RELATIONSHIPS

Has being in the program made you more likely, about the same, or less likely to...? (Percentages of youth who reported "much more" or "somewhat more likely" to the following statements)




#### TPIP YOUTH SPEAK UP

#### **TPIP YOUTH'S EXPERIENCES & SATISFACTION**
