# FY2022 Contract


- Follow-up after Hospitalization for Mental Illness within 30 days for children and adults (FUH-30CH and FUH-30AD)
- Follow-up After Emergency Department Visit for Alcohol and Other Drug Dependence (FUA-30), children and adults combined
- Measurement period:
  - January 1, 2021 – December 31, 2021
  - Health equity scoring will include a comparison of the calendar year (CY) 2021 with (CY) 2020
- Updated MDHHS specification summary
- IET data validation

# FY2022 FUH & FUA Benchmarks


1. Continue 50<sup>th</sup> percentile for FY2022:
  - Adult minimum standard (18+): **58%**
  - Child minimum standard (6-17): **70%**
2. Breaking news! FUA 27% benchmark will NOT be scored in FY22

# FUH Health Equity Analysis




# FUA-30 Health Equity Analysis

# CC360 Update

# CC360 Update - Measures

- All shared metrics are available in CC360 and updated quarterly.
- Measure Rates are available by Race/Ethnicity at the state level, plan level and MHP/PIHP combination level.
- Race/ethnicity has been added to beneficiary level data output, including Quick Analysis and performance measure event details.

# CC360 Update - Measures

- The new way of categorizing Race/Ethnicity *impacts* all measures.
- Updated Measure Rates for IET and FUA are available at the state level, plan level, and MHP/PIHP combination level. The updated rates were generated by original specification codes.

# Removed Codes for FUA/IET FY22 Specification

<b>Follow-up Visit Code</b>	<b>MI Specific SUD Service Code Description</b>
H0006	Substance Use Disorder Case Management.
H0010	Substance Use Disorder: Sub-Acute Withdrawal Management (Sub-Acute Detoxification); medically monitored residential detox.
H0012	Substance Use Disorder: Sub-Acute Withdrawal Management (Sub-Acute Detoxification); residential addiction program outpatient.
H0118 – Except H0018 PO	Substance Use Disorder: Residential Services.
H0019	Substance Use Disorder: Residential Services.
H0038 – Except when reported with NO modifier	Substance Use Disorder: Recover Coach (Peer Services).
H0049	Alcohol and/or drug screening.
H0050	Substance Use Disorder: Outpatient Care.

# Performance Measure Event Level Data

# CC360 Event Level Data

- Performance measure event level data is available in CC360, including beneficiary race/ethnicity.
- FUA measure event level data:
  - is not available in CC360 due to confidentiality requirements for SUD treatment data
  - To be provided to plans through DCH-File Transfer
  - Will be a subset of events, based on submitter of the numerator service
  - Will include additional columns (next slide)

# FUA Event Level Data

Column Name	Variables and Description
County Name	County the beneficiary's Medicaid is in/county of residence
Event	A beneficiary can have one or more ER events. For example, a 3 indicates the third ER visit event included in the file for the beneficiary.
Denom Type	20 indicates the denominator service was an encounter submitted by a MHP or a fee for service claim, 88 denotes the denominator service was submitted by a PIHP under their SUD ID, and 89 means any other PIHP encounter. 99=claim type information unavailable.
Result Flag	YES means MDHHS found evidence of a qualified follow-up service within 30 days, NO means a follow up service was not found within 30 days of the ER visit.
Numerator Type:	20 indicates the numerator service was an encounter submitted by a MHP or a fee for service claim, 88 denotes the numerator service was submitted by a PIHP under their SUD ID, and 89 means any other PIHP encounter. NA means no follow up service was found.
