**SECTION 10e(21) REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE**

Section 10e(21) of Public Act 51 of 1951, as amended (Act 51), states:

After January 1, 1979, the department shall submit an annual report to the legislature detailing the service provided in the prior year for persons 65 years of age or older and persons with disabilities by fixed route service and demand actuated service. This report shall include a report of passenger usage and shall be submitted by April 1 of each year.

The following chart provides information as required by Public Act 51 of 1951. Data for individual transit agencies may be obtained by contacting the Office of Passenger Transportation at 517-335-1692.
