Public Act 51 of 1951 Reporting Requirement – MCL 247.668j (4)

247.668j Annual certification that certain employee-related conditions met; failure to make certification; withholding distributions to local road agency; website; "transportation employee" defined.

Sec. 18j. (4) The department shall maintain a searchable website accessible by the public at no cost. A website maintained by the department under this subsection shall include, but is not limited to, the following: www.Michigan.gov/MDOT
