

**Michigan Department of Transportation Legislative
Reporting Requirement
Public Act 22 of 2025, Article 16, Section 205(8)**

Sec. 205(8). Except as otherwise provided in subsection (9), beginning March 15 of the current fiscal year, the applicable department shall post a report in a publicly accessible location on its website. The report must list the grant recipient, project purpose, and location of the project for each grant described in subsection (1), the status of money allocated and disbursed under the grant agreement, and the legislative sponsor, if applicable. The applicable department shall update the report and post the updated report in a publicly accessible location on its website not later than June 15 of the current fiscal year and again not later than September 15 of the current fiscal year. The applicable department shall include in the report the most comprehensive information the applicable department has available at the time of posting for grants awarded.
