Project Description

Report Period: April-2020

Project Scope: Reconstruction and widening of I-94 from east of the Airport Rd interchange to west of the eastern US-127/I-94 interchange located in Blackman and Leoni Township, Jackson County. Work also includes replacement of the West Ave/US-127/M-50/I-94 interchange, Elm Road interchange, and the Lansing Avenue bridge over I-94. This project will gap out the portion of I-94 currently under construction, from west of the I-94 bridge over the Grand River to east of Cooper Street.
