MDOT Stormwater Treatment Manual Approved for Use

Effective immediately, the MDOT Stormwater Treatment Manual is approved for use on MDOT projects. The manual supplements the MDOT Drainage Manual and provides guidance on complying with MDOT's Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) permit requirements for treating the long-term impacts of stormwater runoff from MDOT projects for water quality and channel protection.

Projects that meet the following criteria are regulated under the MS4 permit and will need to address stormwater impacts:

- Have ≥ 1 acre of earth disturbance, discharge to a water of the state, and modify the drainage system

Or

- Fall within a watershed with an established total maximum daily load (TMDL) for a pollutant
