Beginning with the April 2024 letting, the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) has replaced the use of all 4-inch-wide longitudinal pavement marking lines on state trunkline routes and instead will use 6-inch-wide markings on those routes.

Local Agencies will be allowed to continue to use 4-inch-wide lines on Local Agency projects. On the MDOT "Traffic and Safety" website, two folders have been created under "Pavement Markings" for Local Agencies to use, "Special Details – Local Agency" and "Standards – Local Agency". Links to those two folders are below:

If a Local Agency intends to use 4-inch-wide lines on a Local Agency project and does not have its own unique pavement marking details, use the standards and special details contained in the links.

Currently, MDOT has no plans to remove or make any changes to existing associated pay items for the 4-inch-wide markings.
