



Grant Cancellation Policy

MDOT reserves the right to cancel any grant at any time. Note this policy is limited to the Statewide TAP program. Transportation Management Area (TMA) TAP programs may use their own criteria for grant cancellations. MDOT TAP grant cancellations will be communicated in writing.

While we hope not to cancel grants, there are several situations that may lead to grant cancellation, including but not limited to any of the following:

- Lack of filing a Quarterly Progress Report, if one is required.
- Lack of solid progress each quarter. Grantee progress is measured against the final accepted version of the applicant's schedule, as recorded on the Schedule tab in the MDOT Grant System.
- Requesting a time extension due to issues that were reasonably foreseeable.
- Lack of anyone in responsible charge of the project; MDOT grant coordinator's calls/emails are not responded to in a timely manner.
- Failing to meet any condition of a Conditional Commitment.
- Anticipated right of way can no longer be obtained and there is no viable or feasible alternative.
- Unapproved changes are made to the scope of work.
- Scope of work changes are made that would have negatively impacted the funding recommendation originally determined during the application review process.
- Local Agency Program or Trunkline staff are unable to execute a grant contract with the grantee.
- Grantee agency support has been publicly documented as lost.
- Failure of the grantee to provide approval on an accurate bid letting package to MDOT in the Grant Fiscal Year (failing to achieve federal obligation in the Grant Fiscal Year, where such failure is due to the grantee, not MDOT nor the Federal Highway Administration, and not lack of federal obligation authority).
- Grants can also be cancelled due to a lack of a current year federal spending bill or a federal cut to TAP apportionments.
