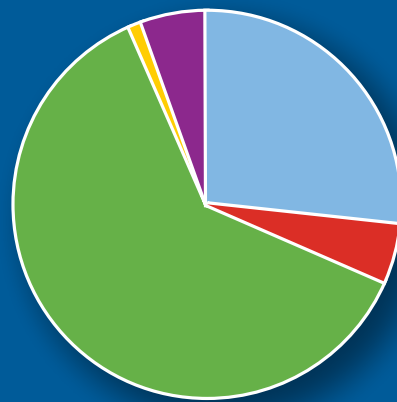
Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program

## Funding Provided for 68 projects in 22 counties

The CMAQ program funds transportation projects or programs that will contribute to the attainment or maintenance of the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) for ozone (NOx and VOC), carbon monoxide (CO), or particulate matter (PM 2.5). The CMAQ program supports two important goals: Improving air quality and relieving congestion.

### CMAQ Investment → \$63,417,936

- \$39.5M in Congestion Reduction & Traffic Flow Improvements
- \$17.2M in Transit Improvements
- \$3.7M in Shared Ride and Travel Demand Management
- \$2.7M in Bicycle & Pedestrian Improvements
- \$337K in Public Education and Outreach Activities



### Emissions Reduction:

Pollutant	Emissions Reduction
<b>NOx</b> Nitrogen Oxides	→ <b>5,277.7901</b> KG/Day
<b>VOC</b> Volatile Organic Compounds	→ <b>2,625.6974</b> KG/Day
<b>CO</b> Carbon Monoxide	→ <b>13,654.5956</b> KG/Day
<b>PM 2.5</b> Particulate Matter	→ <b>3,282.172</b> KG/Day
