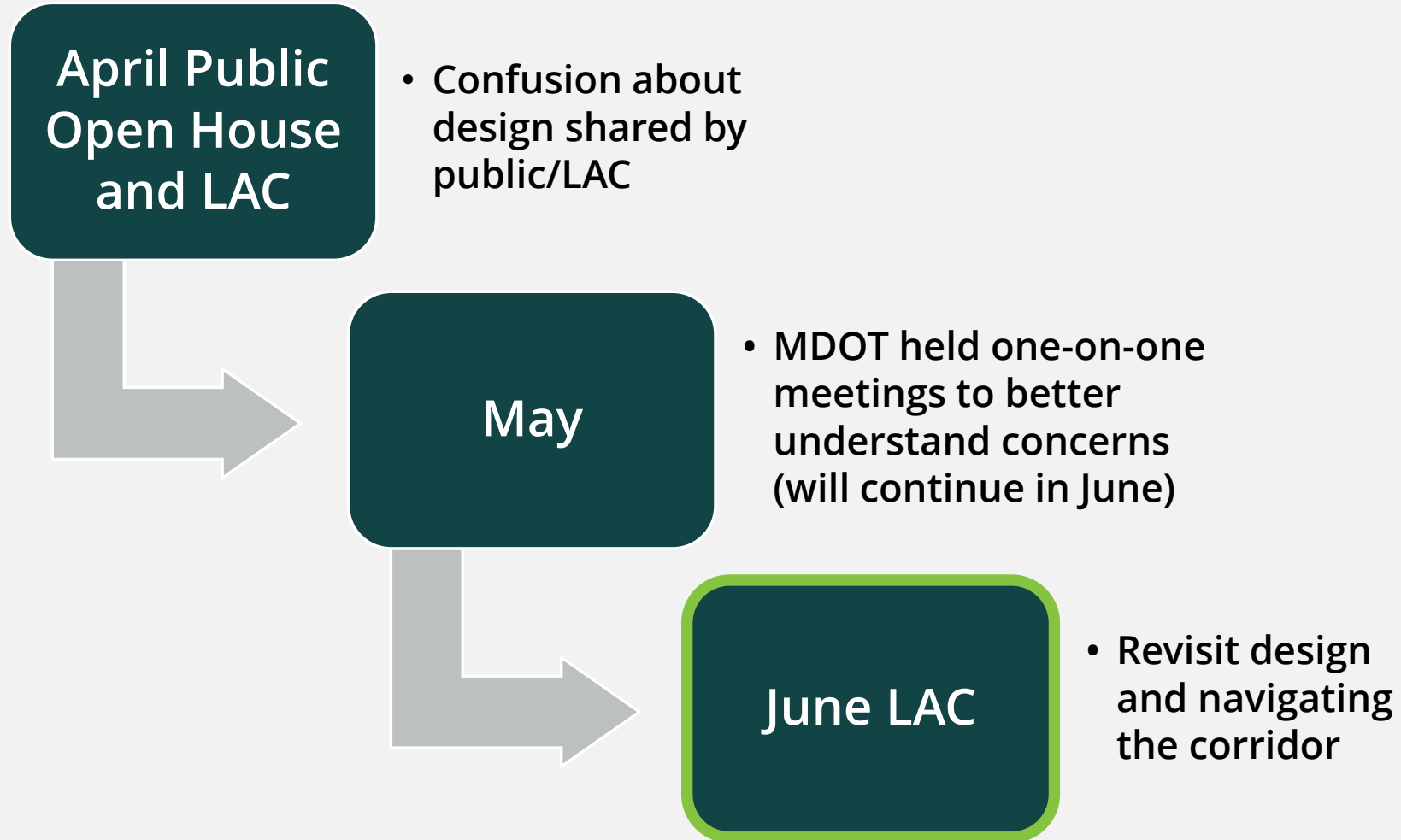

DESIGN ALTERNATIVE DEVELOPMENT

Finalized during NEPA phase:

- The project footprint/limits of the reconstruction
- Number of lanes on the new at-grade boulevard
- Interchange connection ramps at the at-grade boulevard

Design features that can be altered moving forward:

Refinements to geometry:

- Intersection layout
- Freeway ramp layout and curve radii
- Non-motorized path and sidewalk alignment
- Driveway configurations

Implementation of innovative infrastructure:

- Modernized traffic signals
- Signing
- Pavement markings
