



KNOW YOUR LOAD HEIGHT

Overheight vehicle-bridge crashes can cause serious injuries, major damage and traffic delays.

Permits are required for vehicles or loads higher than 13 feet, 6 inches.

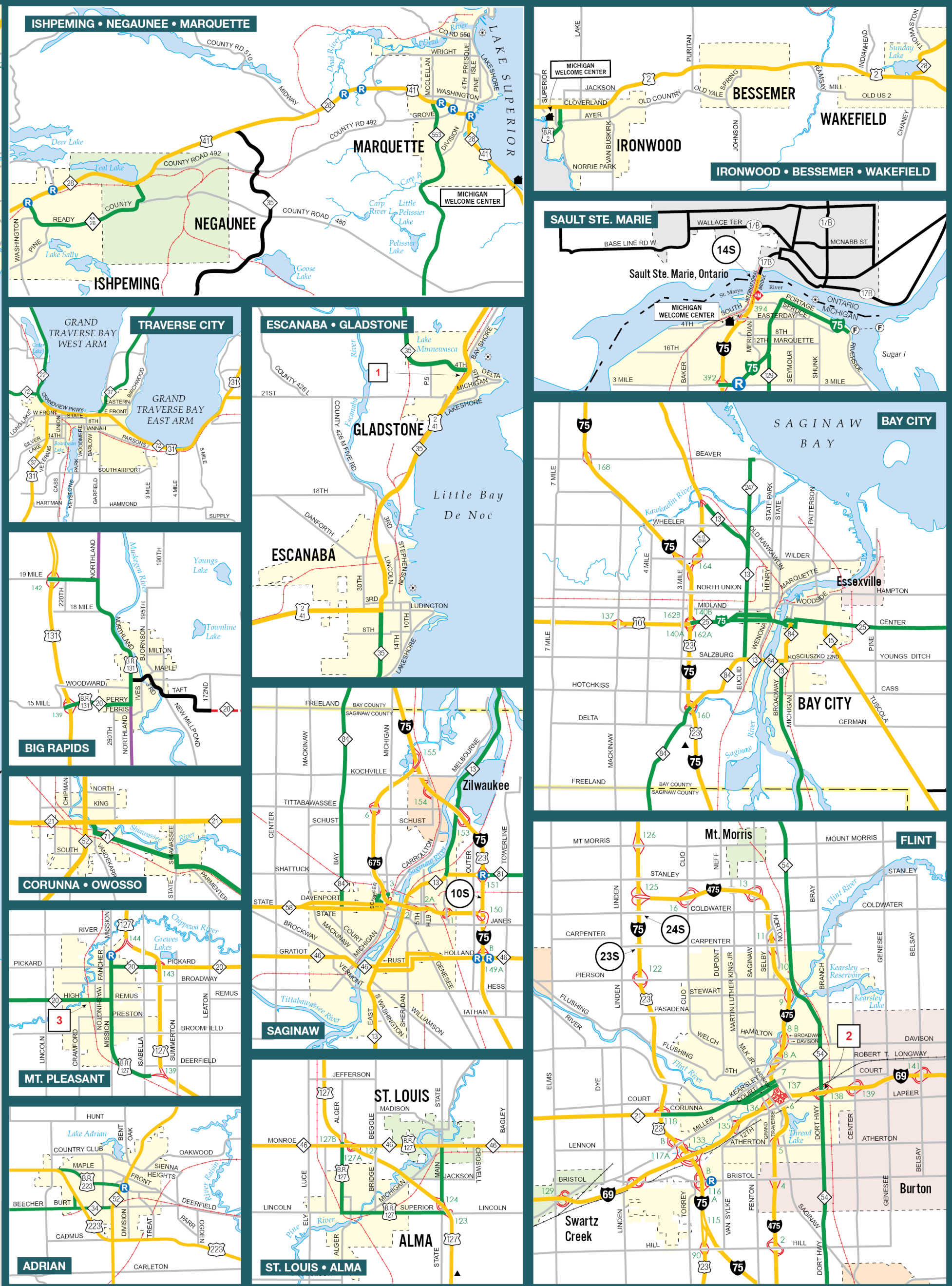
