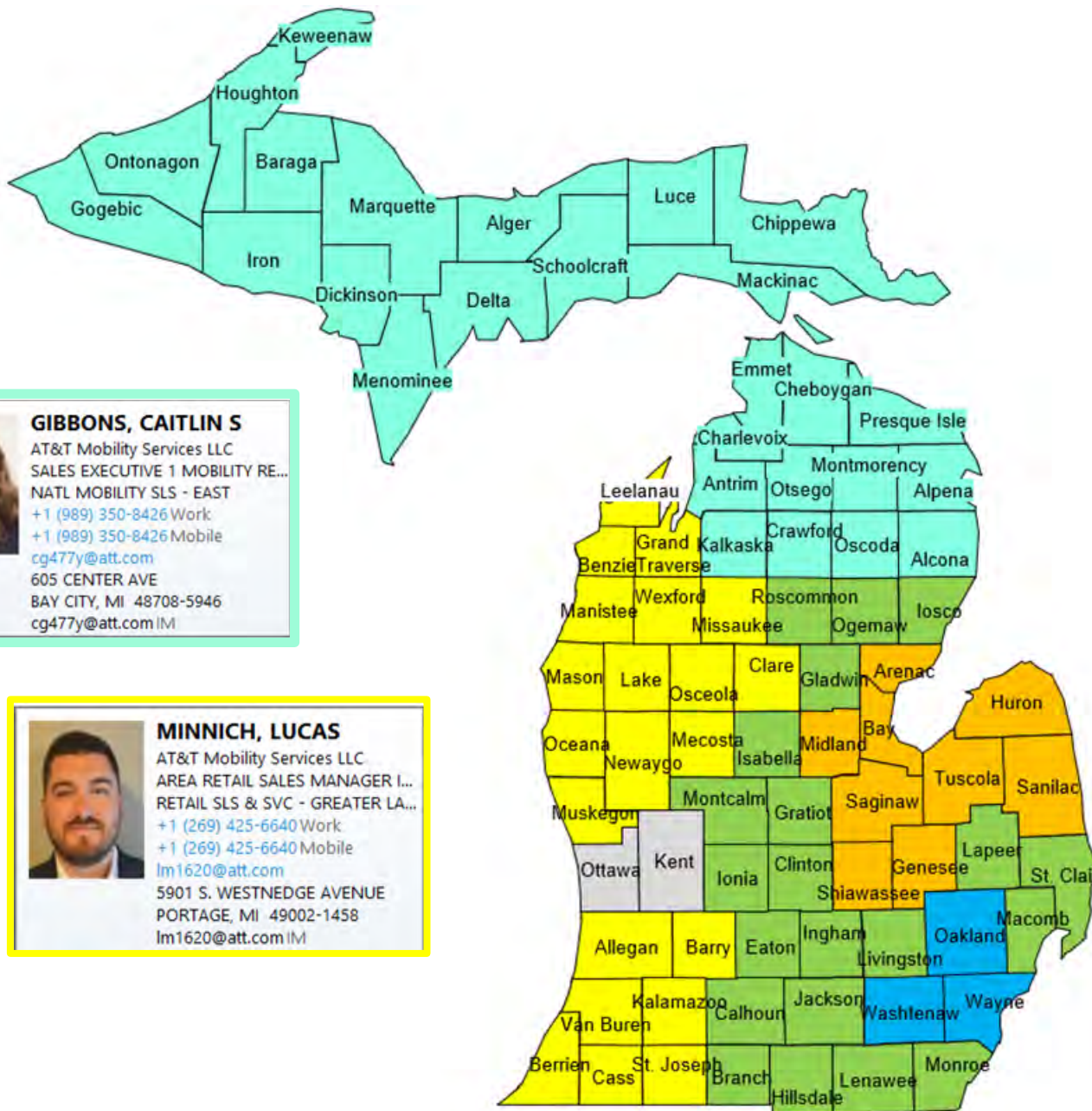

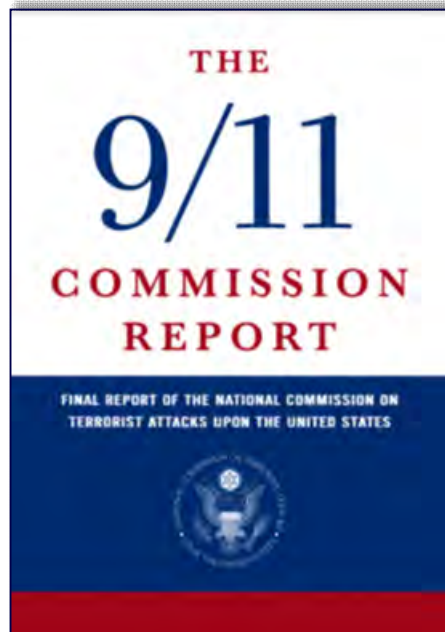

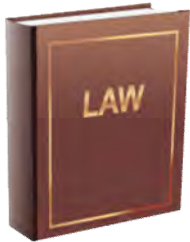

The **FirstNet Board** has **15** members, including those with telecommunications and public safety backgrounds

Each Governor appoints **1 Single Point of Contact (SPOC)** and governing body to represent the state’s interests to FirstNet.

42 member **Public Safety Advisory Committee (PSAC)** advises FirstNet on public safety intergovernmental matters.



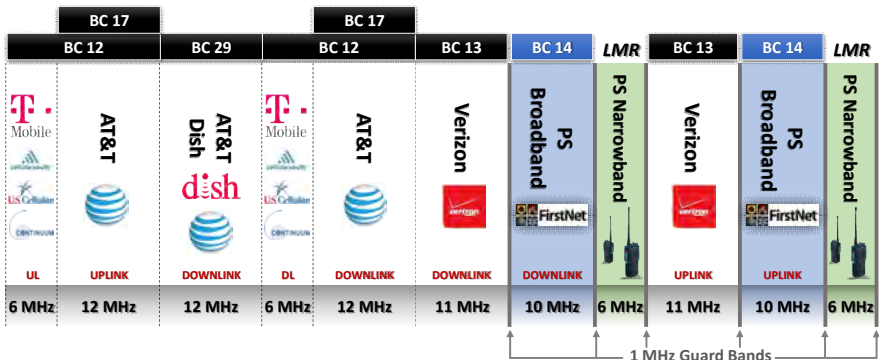
FUNDING

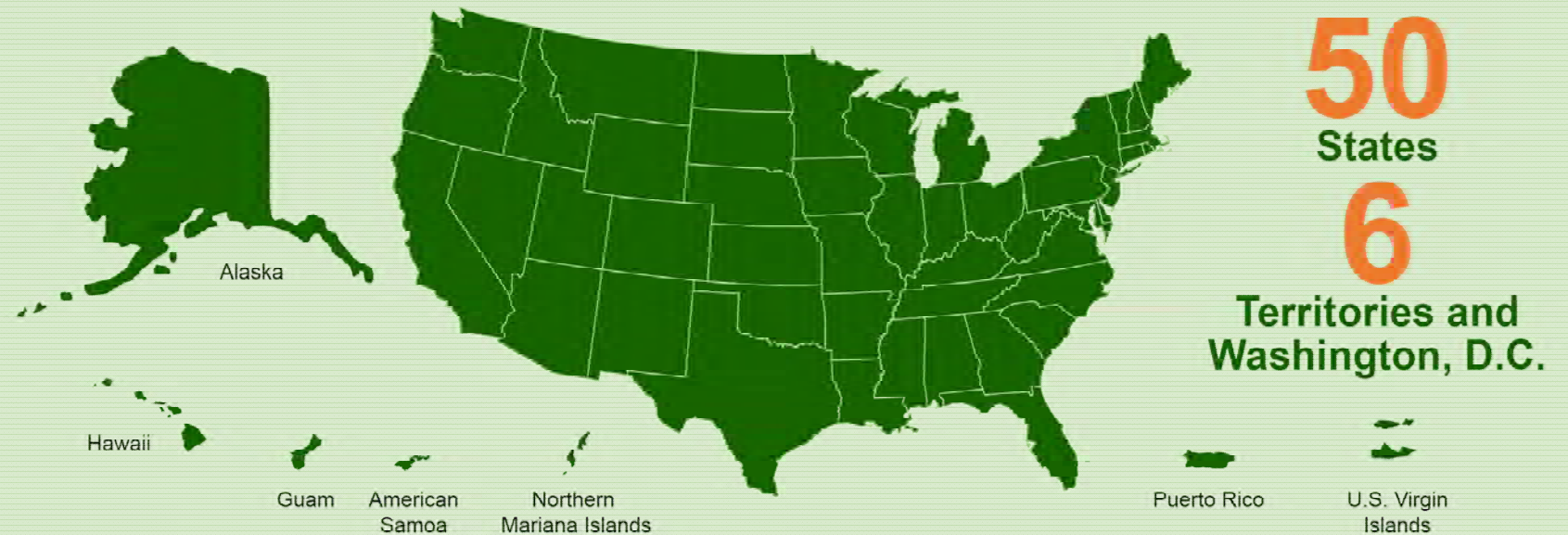

Expanding FirstNet:

The First Responder Network Authority will issue work orders to deploy RANs in opt in states/territories, giving AT&T the green light to expand the network to provide the bandwidth and mission-critical connections for public safety users

The First Responder Network Authority will continue to engage with public safety, states, territories, federal agencies, and tribal nations to ensure the network meets their needs

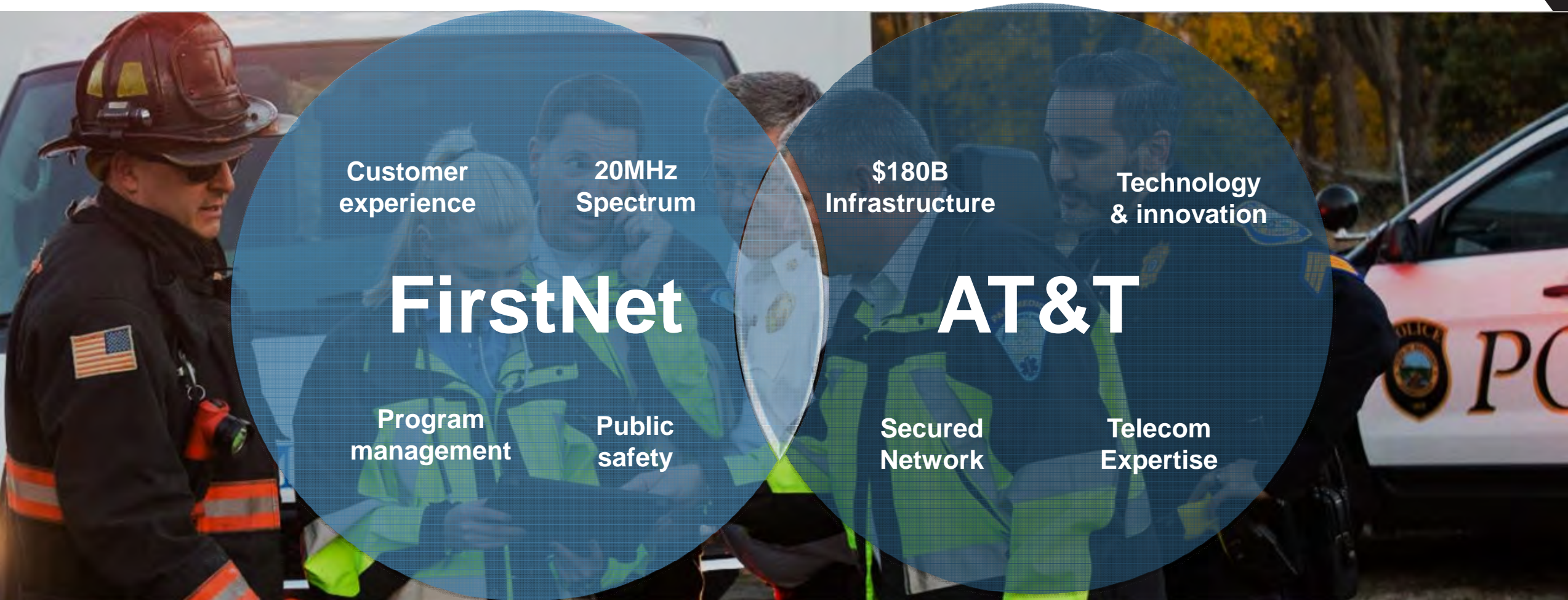

What is QPP (First Priority), And Why Does Public Safety Need It

- Quality of Service (QoS): establishes minimum/maximum service quality parameters
- Priority: Gives users preferred access to network resources
- Preemption: Terminates or relocates lower priority users to provide primary users with access
