## HOV QUICK FACTS

- I-75 HOV lanes are located between 12 Mile Road and South Boulevard in Oakland County.
- $\diamond\,$  I-75 HOV lanes opened in fall 2023.
- The HOV lanes require two or more occupants inside the vehicle during the designated times of Monday through Friday from 6 to 9 a.m. and 3 to 6 p.m.
- Outside of designated times, the HOV lanes are open to all motorists, regardless of the number of occupants.
- Exceptions include motorcycles, transit buses, police, and emergency vehicles.
