RESOLUTION 2025-02

A resolution amending Amended Resolution 2021-01 and Amended Resolution 2021-02. that authorizes the Executive Director to make final determinations on disciplinary actions that have a fine less than \$25,000.00 for violations of the Lawful Internet Gaming Act (LIGA), MCL 432.301 *et seq*, Lawful Sports Betting Act (LSBA), MCL 432.401, *et seq* and applicable administrative rules.

WHEREAS the Michigan Gaming Control Board (Board) delegated certain authority to the Executive Director pursuant to Amended Resolution 2021-01 and Amended Resolution 2021-02.

WHEREAS the Board limited the Executive Director's delegated authority in both resolutions, so it did not include:


1. Making a final determination to approve or deny an application for an operator or supplier license pursuant to LIGA or LSBA.
2. Making a final determination on disciplinary action, including but not limited to suspension, revocation or fines, against an operator or supplier licensee pursuant to LIGA or LSBA.
3. Making a final determination to approve or deny a renewal application for an operator or supplier license pursuant to LIGA or LSBA.

WHEREAS the Board finds it is necessary and desirable, for purposes of administrative efficiency and to effectively execute LIGA and LSBA, to expressly delegate to the Executive Director the authority to make final determinations on disciplinary actions that have a fine less than \$25,000.00, against an operator or supplier licensee for violation of LIGA, LSBA, or their applicable administrative rules.

THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the Board delegates its authority to the Executive Director to make final determinations on disciplinary actions that have a fine less than \$25,000.00 against an operator or supplier licensee for violation of LIGA, LSBA, or their applicable administrative rules.
