ORDER EXTENDING CONDITIONAL TEMPORARY  
THIRD-PARTY FACILITATOR LICENSE

As permitted by 8(1)(d)(vi)(A) of the Horse Racing Law of 1995 (Act), MCL 431.308(1)(d)(A), the temporary third-party facilitator license originally granted on September 3, 2020, is extended for an additional 6 months beginning June 2, 2021. Churchill Downs must still comply with the Act, the Administrative Rules, and the Order Establishing Terms, Conditions, and Fees for Third Party Facilitators issued on May 5, 2020. The Executive Director may issue sanctions including, but not limited to, revocation or suspension of a license, exclusion from racetrack grounds, or a fine.
