
**ORDER EXTENDING CONDITIONAL TEMPORARY  
THIRD-PARTY FACILITATOR LICENSE**

On October 15, 2021, NYRABets, LLC (NYRABets) was granted a conditional temporary third-party facilitator license, which expires on December 31, 2022.

As permitted by § 8(1)(d)(vi)(A) of the Horse Racing Law of 1995 (Act), NYRABets' conditional temporary third-party facilitator license is extended until February 28, 2023, or until one of the following occurs: (1) NYRABets' joint contract expires or is terminated; (2) the conditional license is suspended or revoked; (3) NYRABets withdraws its application or it is denied; or (4) the Executive Director grants NYRABets' application for a TPF license.

NYRABets must comply with the Act, the Rules, and Executive Director Orders. Failing to comply may result in sanctions including, but not limited to, revocation or suspension of NYRABets' license, exclusion from racetrack grounds, or a fine. NYRABets understands that full licensure is conditioned on meeting the terms, conditions, and suitability standards contained in § 8(1)(d) and § 10(1)(e), (f) of the Act, and the Rules.
