**ORDER CANCELLING LIVE RACING
AT NORTHVILLE DOWNS**

J. Carlo, P. Battista, and M. Zayti Partnership, d/b/a Northville Downs requested cancellation of live racing on Friday, March 11, 2022, due to lack of entries. The Michigan Harness Horsemen's Association supported the request and has consented to allowing simulcast wagering on March 11, 2022. See MCL 431.312(3).

Pursuant to §6(b) of the October 27, 2021, Order Granting a 2022 Race Meeting License and 2022 Simulcast Permit (Order), live racing dates cannot be cancelled except for those reasons permissible under the Horse Racing Law of 1995, MCL 431.301 through 431.336, and administrative rules

For the lack of ability to program and conduct 8 live horse races on a racing date awarded to Northville Downs in the Order and because there are fewer than 5 entries in a race, it is ordered that Northville Down's request to cancel live racing on Friday, March 11, 2022, is approved.
