Please be advised the Michigan Gaming Control Board (Board) recently revised and published several technical bulletins. These technical bulletins address communications, data logging, server and equipment location, and geofencing specification and testing. Each of these technical bulletins have been posted to the Board's website, on the [Technical Bulletins and Memos](#) page.

The revisions are summarized as follows:

*Communications (Technical Bulletin 2023-02)*

- Added rule reference numbers where rules requirements are provided.

*Data Logging (Technical Bulletin 2023-03)*

- Added rule reference numbers where rules requirements are provided.

*Server and Equipment Location (Technical Bulletin 2024-01)*

- Added rule reference numbers where rules requirements are provided.
- Added language to address multijurisdictional poker authorized under the Lawful Internet Gaming Act.

*Geofencing Specifications and Testing (Technical Bulletins 2024-03 and 2024-04)*

- Added rule reference numbers where rules requirements are provided.
- Added language to address multijurisdictional poker authorized under the Lawful Internet Gaming Act.
- Updated reporting and analytics section of Geofencing Specifications Technical Bulletin (2024-03) to align with current industry standards.

- Removed specific trouble-shooter message language and replaced with the types of scenarios that must be addressed in the Geofencing Specifications Technical Bulletin (2024-03).
- Removed requirement for the Board to review and approve field testing plans in the Geofencing Testing Technical Bulletin (2024-04).
