The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services(MDHHS) maintains a 24-hour toll-free helpline, 800-270-7117, to call if you or someone you know has a gambling problem. Trained professionals under contract with MDHHS answer the helpline calls, coordinate the initial consultations with qualified counselors, provide financial assistance information, and oversee ongoing treatment of clients when necessary.

RESPONSIBLE GAMING DATABASE UNDER THE LAWFUL INTERNET GAMING ACT AND LAWFUL SPORTS BETTING ACT

(Excerpted from Section 432.312 and 432.412)

To help those who believe they have a problem with online gambling, the Michigan Gaming Control Board (MGCB) may develop responsible gaming measures, including a statewide Responsible Gaming Database (RGD) identifying individuals who are prohibited from establishing an internet wagering or internet sports betting account or participating in internet gaming or internet sports betting offered by an internet gaming operator or sports betting operator.

HOW CAN I ADD MY NAME TO THE RGD?

- Complete the application in person at an MGCB office.

WHAT KIND OF INFORMATION IS ON THE APPLICATION?

- Full name and aliases
- Current home address and phone numbers
- Social Security number
- Date of birth
- Email address
- Driver's License or State Identification Number
- Acknowledgement you understand the terms for placement in the RGD

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I SUBMIT MY APPLICATION TO MGCB?

- The MGCB Responsible Gaming Representative will email written confirmation you have been placed in the RGD, which could take up to 45 days from application submission.
- You will be prohibited from establishing and/or using an internet wagering account or an internet sports betting account or both.

WHO GETS A COPY OF THE RGD?

The list will be shared with internet gaming operators and internet gaming platform providers, internet sports betting operators and internet sports betting platform providers, and affected MGCB personnel.

WILL MY NAME BE RELEASED TO THE PUBLIC?

No. All information and records used by the board in the administration of the RGD are exempt from disclosure under section 13 of the Freedom of Information Act.

CAN I GET OFF THE LIST ONCE I'M ON IT?

You have the option of selecting 1 year or 5 years self-exclusion from internet gaming or internet sports betting or both. Your name will be automatically removed when the time expires.
