Baraga County was set off from Houghton County in 1875. The county coordinates are Ranges 31 West through 35 West (31W-35W) and Townships 47 North through 52 North (47N-52N). Lake Superior is on the northern border of Baraga County. Adjacent counties include Marquette (east), Iron (south), and Houghton (west).

Original records from Baraga County are available at the Archives of Michigan. The list below is organized by record type; each record type lists specific records, the years of coverage and the record group (RG) number assigned to that collection.
