## ARCHIVES OF MICHIGAN



Gladwin County was originally laid off in 1831, but was later officially organized in 1875. The county coordinates are Ranges 2 West through 2 East (2W-2E) and Townships 17 North through 20 North (17N-20N). Adjacent counties include Roscommon (northwest), Ogemaw (northeast), Arenac (east), Bay (southeast), Saginaw (south), Isabella (southwest), and Clare (west).

Original records from Gladwin County are available at the Archives of Michigan. The list below is organized by record type; each record type lists specific records, the years of coverage and the record group (RG) number assigned to that collection. A more detailed list of each collection can be found in finding aids at the archives.
