

Application Marker Repair and Replacement Fund

Each year the Michigan Historical Commission and the Michigan History Center (Center) set aside a limited amount of funding to help cover the expenses related to the repair, refinishing, or replacement of Michigan Historical Markers. These funds are available annually on a first-come, first-awarded basis.

- For accepted applications, the fund will cover 60% of the cost to repair, refinish, purchase replacement posts or replace the marker. The applicant will be responsible for the remaining 40%.
- Applicants must submit the entire 40% of cost within 90 days of receiving notification that an application has been accepted into the program. Once the 40% is received by the Center, the needed work will be ordered.
- If the applicant portion is not received by the required date, the funds reserved for the project will be released for use by other applicants.
