The WAMC was created to lead, guide, and assist communities in the development and/or enhancement of their drinking water, wastewater, and stormwater asset management programs. The WAMC is legislatively charged with the development of asset management templates, as well as annual reporting to the Michigan Infrastructure Council on the asset condition and investment of water infrastructure across the state.
