





Ensure each plan complies with the seven-ranked redistricting criteria, deliberations on which maps to move forward, and vote.





# REQUEST ADDITIONAL STATE FUNDING



- Due to the pending litigation, the MICRC will need to request additional funding from the Michigan Legislature.
- The recent court order from the United States District Court Western District of Michigan Southern Division requires the Commission the costs and expenses of the Reviewing Special Master and the Mapping Special Master, and their respective teams subject to the Court's approval.
- In addition, the Commission's budget did not consider in-person meetings and increased legals costs for pending litigation.

# BUDGETING

- Special Masters
  - Grofman—\$160,000
  - Suggest--\$320,000
- Potential Legal Fee for Commissioner Eid's representation
  - Unknown



# PUBLIC HEARING

- Court Order requires a public hearing in Detroit on the maps due to the Court Friday, Feb. 2 before Friday, Feb. 23.
- Recommend a public hearing Thursday afternoon and evening, Feb. 15 in Detroit.
