Mr. Woods stated to you on the record (while the formal motion/second was immediately pending) that; "having them go back and document rules of procedure and how we followed our practices as relates to spending expenditures". The current audit documents only talks about general accounting practices and not specific practices approved by majority vote of this Commission.

I've spoken several times with the Auditor General's office about this issue and there seems to be a misunderstanding that should be addressed by the voting members of the MICRC by Resolution and not through second or third hand information that can easily evolve into "misinformation" and/or "disinformation" as we see happening regularly on the news.
